

PRIVACY POLICY

SUMMARY

This privacy policy (the "Privacy Policy") is intended to inform you of Theracos, Inc. and its affiliates (referred to herein as "Theracos" or "us") policies and practices regarding the collection, use and disclosure of information that you provide to us when you visit <http://www.theracos.com/> (the "Site"). This Privacy Policy includes information on how we use your Personal Information (as defined below), how we protect the security of that information, and how you may change or request that we amend your Personal Information within our systems. This includes any Personal Information that is supplied to us in connection with your use of the Site, as well as information we generate regarding your use of the Site, in either case, information that does, or that can be used to identify you. This Privacy Policy applies solely to Personal Information collected through use of the Site. By using the Site, you indicate that you agree to this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with this Privacy Policy, you should not use the Site. This Privacy Policy may change from time to time. Changes are effective the date that they are published, so please check back periodically to ensure that you have reviewed the most current version of this Privacy Policy. DEFINITIONS

"Personal Information" is information about you that is personally identifiable to you like your name, address, state of residence, and e-mail address.

HOW INFORMATION IS COLLECTED

We collect certain Personal Information through the Site when you choose to submit such information to us through email, such as contacting us through our "Contact Us" Site function. This information may include, but is not limited to, name, company name, physical address, telephone number and email address and includes such personal information that you provide to us in order to request additional information about our business, employment opportunities or for other purposes. We use this Personal Information to respond to specific requests for information.

You do not need to provide this Personal Information to us, but if you do not, we will not be able to respond to your communication. We will collect and use this Personal Information for our legitimate business interests to understand and respond to business inquiries. We will keep this information for as long as you have a relationship with us, or if you do not have a relationship with us beyond this communication, for a reasonable length of time that permits us to respond to your request.

While using the Site, you may learn about institutions participating in Theracos research studies and you may elect to provide Personal Information to these investigational sites; for example, you may contact an investigational site to learn more about a study. In such an event, Theracos will not be privy to any Personal Information that you provide to the institution and your Personal Information will be subject to the privacy policies of that institution.

INFORMATION WE TRACK

Log Files

The Site gathers certain information automatically (as do many websites) and stores it in web server log files. This information includes internet protocol address (a computer's numerical internet address), browser type, internet service provider (ISP), site entry/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and clickstream data. Such information may be treated as Personal Information under certain applicable

local law. Theracos or those working on its behalf, may use this information to improve the Site, analyze trends, administer the Site and gather general information about Site access and use.

Cookies

Our Site uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of the Site and to collect information about your online preferences. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Site and also helps us to improve the Site. By continuing to browse the Site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

Cookies allow us to recognize and count the number of visitors to the Site and see how visitors move around on the Site when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way that the Site works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily. We also use cookies to recognize you when you return to the Site. This enables us to remember your preferences, such as choice of language or region.

Most internet browsers are automatically set up to accept cookies. However, you can block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse all or some cookies. SALE OR MERGER OF THERACOS

Subject to applicable law, Site user information is a business asset of our company. If we are sold to or merged with another company, our user information may be transferred to a successor of the company, who will agree to abide by the terms of this Privacy Policy. You have the right to request that your Personal Information be removed from our systems at any time.

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Theracos will disclose Personal Information 1) in response to lawful requests by public authorities, including to meet national security or law enforcement requirements; and 2) in our sole discretion if we believe that such disclosure is appropriate in connection with an official government or regulatory investigation or in response to a perceived significant threat to a person's health or property or to our business.

We may also process your Personal Information if necessary in the defense of a legal claim. We will not delete Personal Information if relevant to an investigation or dispute. It will continue to be stored until those issues are fully resolved.

CURRENCY AND ACCURACY OF INFORMATION

Theracos endeavors to keep the Site current but there can be no guarantee that Site information is complete or accurate at any given time. Site users are advised to learn as much as possible about clinical trials of interest, including eligibility requirements and associated risks that may not be included on a clinical trial-related website. Site users should discuss clinical trial risks, benefits and alternatives and all clinical trial-related questions with investigators and investigational site personnel.

OTHER WEBSITES

SECURITY

Theracos uses reasonable measures to maintain the security of the Site, consistent with the nature of the information collected on the Site. Theracos' security measures include administrative, technical and physical safeguards necessary to (a) ensure the security, confidentiality, and integrity of your Personal Information; (b) protect against any anticipated threats or hazards to the security, confidentiality and integrity of your Personal Information; (c) protect against unauthorized access to, destruction, modification, disclosure or use of your Personal Information. We permit persons working for us to access and use your Personal Information only to serve our legitimate business interest and customers' service needs in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

NOTICE FOR VISITORS FROM OUTSIDE OF THE UNITED STATES

Your Personal Information may be stored and processed in any country in which we engage service providers, including countries outside of where you are located. Where cross border transfers of your Personal Information are necessary, they are made in accordance with applicable law. For example, if we are required to transfer your Personal Information outside of the European Economic Area (EEA), the transfer of this information will be governed by a contract including standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission.

YOUR RIGHTS

If you are a resident of the EEA, you have certain rights regarding our use of your Personal Information as collected under this Privacy Policy. Some of these rights, e.g., the right to be forgotten or the right to request that we transfer your information to another country, will only apply in certain circumstances. Generally, these rights will not be available if there are outstanding contracts between us, if we are required by law to keep the information or if the information is relevant to a legal dispute.

We have listed the rights you have over your Personal Information and how you can use them below. These rights are subject to restrictions under European data protection law and, subject to the exemptions in that law, may only apply to certain types of information or processing.

1. We need your consent to some of the ways we use your Personal Information, such as for marketing or processing special categories of Personal Information about you. You can remove that consent at any time.
2. You can ask us to confirm that we are processing your Personal Information and if we are, you can ask for access to that information and details regarding:
 - a. Why we are using your information
 - b. What information we are using
 - c. Who we have shared that information with
 - d. The period for which your information will be stored, or how we determine that period
 - e. Your right to object to our processing of your information, your right to have your information erased or the processing of your information restricted
 - f. Your right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority
 - g. The source of your information where it has not been provided by you
 - h. The existence of any automated decision-making processes using your data or any profiling

- i. The transfers of your information to countries outside of the EEA and the safeguards in place
 - j. Your right to a copy of the information about you which is being processed by us
- 3. You can ask us to correct your information if it's wrong
- 4. You can ask us to delete your information
- 5. You can ask us to restrict how we use your information
- 6. You can ask us to help you move some of your information to other companies
- 7. You have a right to ask that we provide your information in an easily readable format to another company
- 8. You can ask us to stop using your information, but only in certain cases
- 9. You have the right to complain to the relevant supervisory authority.

You also have a right to object to us processing your Personal Information in some circumstances. You can ask us to stop processing your Personal Information at any time. In certain circumstances, we may not be able to do this or may not be required by law to do this. For example, if there are outstanding contracts between us, if we are required by law to keep the information or if the information is relevant to a legal dispute then we may not stop processing your Personal Information.

If you reside or are located in the EEA, we keep your Personal Information for no longer than necessary for the purposes for which that Personal Information was obtained or processed. The length of time we retain Personal Information depends on the purposes for which we collect and use it and/or as required to comply with applicable laws and to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights.
